- DAY ONE:** AVADE® Level 1 training covers the basics of identifying, understanding, and responding to behavioral health situations to educate, prevent, and manage crisis effectively.
- DAY TWO:** The first half of the day is dedicated to refining teaching techniques for AVADE® Level 1, aimed at improving learning outcomes and information retention. The second half of the day focuses on AVADE® Level II self-defense tactics/techniques tailored to the behavioral health setting.
- DAY THREE:** Participants will review AVADE® Level II self-defense tactics and then proceed to learn AVADE® Level III defensive control tactics.
